Sunstein Patents Yield \$115M Jury Verdict!

Boston – August 4, 2011. A Virginia jury yesterday awarded \$115 million to ActiveVideo Networks, Inc. for Verizon Communications' (NYSE:VZ) infringement of patents prosecuted by Bruce Sunstein, Robert Asher and John Stickevers at the Boston firm of Sunstein Kann Murphy & Timbers LLP.

Almost twenty years ago, Silicon Valley founders retained the Sunstein firm to obtain patents for the interactive television intellectual property of ActiveVideo Networks™, then known as ICTV®. Since then, Sunstein and his partners have obtained issuance of an entire portfolio of patents protecting the ideas which became the CLOUDTV™ platform currently offered by ActiveVideo to cable television providers and consumer electronics manufacturers.

“We are gratified that our work has helped ActiveVideo protect its important innovations against a giant like Verizon, and win such a substantial damages award,” said Bruce Sunstein, founder of the law firm.

ActiveVideo now seeks payment of the award and an injunction against further unlawful use of the technology by Verizon.
